acid	'æ.s.ɪd	azido
any of various usually liquid substances which can react chemically with and sometimes dissolve other materials: <i>acetic/hydrochloric/lactic acid</i> <i>Vinegar is an acid.</i>		
inorganic	ˌɪn.ɔː'ɡæn.ɪk	ez-organikoa
not being or consisting of living material, or (of chemical substances) containing no carbon or only small amounts of carbon: <i>Salt is an inorganic chemical.</i> <i>The meteorites contained only inorganic material</i>		
hydrochloric acid	ˌhaɪ.drə.klɔːr.ɪk'æ.s.ɪd	azido klorhidrikoa
an acid containing hydrogen and chlorine		
chloride	'klɔː.raɪd	kloruro
a chemical compound that is a mixture of chlorine and another substance: <i>Sodium chloride is the chemical name for common salt</i>		
hydrogen	'haɪ.drɪ.dʒən	hidrogeno
the lightest gas, with no colour, taste or smell, that combines with oxygen to form water		
sulfide	'sʌl.faɪd	sulfuro
chemical formed from sulphur and another element		
sulfuric acid	sʌlˌfjʊə.rɪk'æ.s.ɪd	azido sulfurikoa
nitric acid	ˌnaɪ.trɪk'æ.s.ɪd	azido nitrikoa
sulfurous acid	'sʌl.fɪr.əs'æ.s.ɪd	azido sulfurosoa
phosphoric acid	fɒs'fɔːr.ɪk'æ.s.ɪd	azido fosforikoa
